- (1) Number of Homoeopathic Institutions already existing in the State: - **47**
- (2) Number of seats available or number of Homoeopathic Practitioners being produced annually :- **2200**
- (3) Number of Homoeopathic Practitioners registered with the State Council of Indian Systems of Medicine : - **50500 (approximately)**
- (4) Number of Homoeopathic Practitioners in State Government service :- **Not Available**
- (5) Number of vacant Government posts of Homoeopathic doctors in the State particularly in rural/difficult areas :- **Not Available**
- (6) Number of Homoeopathic doctors registered with Employment Exchange: - **Not Available**
- (7) Homoeopathic doctors is to population ratio in the State: - **1:2562**
- (8) How the increased intake capacity of College would resolve the problem of deficiencies of qualified medical personnel in the State and improve the availability of such medical manpower in the State: -
This will help the State Government to resolve the problem of deficiencies of qualified medical personnel in the teaching field. Besides, since the majority of the doctors of this faculty are practicing in rural areas, the proposed increase in intake capacity would increase the availability of doctors in these areas.



(9) The restrictions imposed by the State Government, if any, on students who are not domiciled in the State from obtaining admissions in the State be specified:-
As per the rules laid down by the Government of Maharashtra from time to time.

(10) Full justification for increase in admission capacity: -
Increase in admission capacity would create more educational opportunities for aspiring students This will help the State Government to resolve the problem of deficiencies of qualified medical personnel in the teaching field. Besides, since the majority of the doctors of this faculty are practicing in the rural area, the proposed increase in the intake capacity would increase the availability of doctors in these areas.

(11) Homoeopathic doctors to population ratio to be achieved - **1:1000**

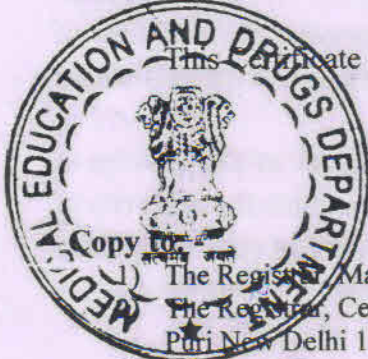
The Principal, Anantrao Kanase Homoeopathic Medical College & Hospital, Alephata, Tal. Junner, Dist.Pune- 412 411 had applied to the Maharashtra University of Health Sciences, Nasik to increase the admission capacity of B.H.M.S. course and the said University has recommended to this Government to grant approval to the proposal. The Government of Maharashtra, after conducting inspection of college through the Directorate of AYUSH, Mumbai and considering the report thereof, has decided to issue "No Objection Certificate" to the applicant to increase the admission capacity of B.H.M.S. Course from 50 to 100 seats.

It is certified that -

- a) The applicant owns and manages a 25-bedded Hospital.
- b) It is desirable in the public interest to increase the admission capacity of B.H.M.S. Course from 50 to 100 seats.
- c) Increase in the admission capacity of B.H.M.S. Course from 50 to 100 by the Anantrao Kanase Homoeopathic Medical College & Hospital, Alephata, Tal. Junner, Dist.Pune is feasible.
- d) It is also certified that adequate clinical material as per the norms of Central Council of Homeopathy, is available with the existing Homoeopathic College.

It is further certified that in case the Applicant fails to create infrastructure for the Homoeopathic College as per Central Council of Homeopathy norms and fresh admissions are stopped by the Central Council / Central Government, the State Government shall take over the responsibility of the students already admitted in the College with the permission of the Central Government.

This certificate shall be valid for *three* years from the date of issue.
