


## History of ECG




Willem Einthoven (21 May 1860 – 29 September 1927) was a Dutch doctor and physiologist. He invented the first practical electrocardiograph (ECG or EKG) in 1895 and received the Nobel Prize in Physiology or Medicine in 1924 for it ("for the discovery of the mechanism of the electrocardiogram").

Before Einthoven's time, it was known that the beating of the heart produced electrical currents, but the instruments of the time could not accurately measure this phenomenon without placing electrodes directly on the heart. Beginning in 1901, Einthoven completed a series of prototypes of a string galvanometer.



Although later technological advances brought about better and more portable EKG devices, much of the terminology used in describing an EKG originated with Einthoven. His assignment of the letters P, Q, R, S and T to the various deflections are still used. The term Einthoven's triangle is named after him.

Limb leads should be placed on the limbs to record a diagnostic 12-Lead.




It refers to the imaginary inverted equilateral triangle centered on the chest and the points being the standard leads on the arms and leg.

After his development of the string galvanometer, Einthoven went on to describe the electrocardiographic features of a number of cardiovascular disorders.














Candida is a common fungus affecting skin and lungs. The research shows that a nosode prepared from Candida fungus was able to inhibit the growth of candida fungus in the laboratory. Its success was as effective as standard anti-fungal medicine called amphotericin.


Similarly, the homeopathic nosodes prepared from (Salmonella typhi) in certain doses could inhibit the growth of the germs similar to that by Ciprofloxacin and Ofloxacin. A new drug prepared from E. Coli could also inhibit the growth of E. Coli bacteria as effectively as the previously mentioned antibiotics. Typhoid and E. 
# Electrohomeopathy

Mattei cancer cure is a derivative of homeopathy invented in the 19th century by Count Cesare Mattei. # Hydrostatic Test:-


(Raygat's test ,1st life test)

• Definition – Hydrostatic test is the test involving floatation of lungs on water, to confirm live birth.

Procedure:-



Whole lungs with trachea, heart & thymus



Squeeze the lung pieces between thumb and index finger under water to see ifair escapes.



- 1. If all lung pieces float after applyi pressure----respiration had been established
- 2. Some of the pieces float-partial inflation of lung ,baby lived for sh period of birth.& partially respire
- Whole lung & cut pieces sink, 3. respiration had not been established.



# Principle:-

The specific gravity of a non respired lung is 1040-1050 & of a respired lung is 940- 950, so the respired lung floats on water (sp. gr. of water is 1000). The increased volume of lungs after respiration, well compensates the increasein weight after respiration.

# INVERSION OF UTERUS



INTRO DUCTION- Uterine inversion occurs when the uterine fundus collapses into the endometrial cavity, turning the uterus partially or completely inside out.

# CLASSIFICATION

Uterine inversions are classified by the extent of inversion and time of

occurrence:


Extent of inversion (figure 1) [6-8]:

Ist degree (also called incomplete) – The fundus is within the endometrial cavity

2nd degree (also called complete) – The fundus protrudes through the cervical os

Ord degree (also called prolapsed) – The fundus protrudes to or beyond the introitus

DIFINATION- Infertility is defined as trying to get pregnant with frequent, unprotected sex for at least a year with no success.

# SYMPTOMS-

The main symptom of infertility is the inability to get pregnant. A menstrual cycle that's too long (35 days

or more), too short (less than 21 days), irregular or absent can mean that you're not ovulating. There might be no other signs or symptoms.

# CAUSES-

For pregnancy to occur, every step of the human reproduction process has to happen correctly. The steps in this process are:

One of the two ovaries releases a mature egg.

The egg is picked up by the fallopian tube.

Sperm swim up the cervix, through the uterus and into the fallopian tube to reach the egg for fertilization.

The fertilized egg travels down the fallopian tube to the uterus.

The fertilized egg attaches (implants) to the inside of the uterus and grows.

# **RISK FACTORS-**

- 1.Age. The quality and quantity of a woman's eggs begin to decline with age. In the mid-30s, the rate of follicle loss speeds, resulting in fewer and poorer quality eggs. This makes conception more difficult, and increases the risk of miscarriage.
- 2.Smoking. Besides damaging your cervix and fallopian tubes, smoking increases your risk of miscarriage and ectopic pregnancy. It's also thought to age your ovaries and deplete your eggs prematurely. Stop smoking before beginning fertility treatment.
- 3.Weight. Being overweight or significantly underweight may affect ovulation. Getting to a healthy body mass index (BMI) might increase the frequency of ovulation and likelihood of pregnancy.
