

Day 5 of the NSS camp was conducted on the occasion of Gandhi Jayanti and was dedicated to the **Swachh Bharat Abhiyan**. Inspired by the ideals of Mahatma Gandhi, cleanliness and community hygiene were promoted through active participation of both NSS volunteers and villagers. The cleanliness drive was carried out in three villages — **Bota, Malwadi, and Kurhadewasti**. Volunteers divided into groups and cleaned public areas such as streets, community spaces, school surroundings, and Anganwadi premises. Dustbins were placed at necessary spots, and awareness was created regarding segregation of dry and wet waste.
